# **Big Cedar Industrial Center**

Cedar Rapids, Iowa

# **Property and area**

One of the largest in the Midwest, this 1,391-acre site provides an excellent multi-modal transportation infrastructure. Get direct access to the CRANDIC (Cedar Rapids and Iowa City Railway) line. Through the Iowa Interstate Railroad, CRANDIC connects to all Class I railroads.

Interstate 380, U.S. four-lane highways 151 and 30 and the Eastern Iowa Airport are less than five miles from the site. The airport is a designated foreign trade zone, offering direct flights to 14 U.S. cities. Cedar Rapids' strong manufacturing industry represents over 16% of the jobs in the area.

# **Existing supply: Alliant Energy**

#### Distribution

- Operating voltage: 25 kV.
- Current capacity: 85 MW of excess capacity.
- Proximity of substation: On-site in the NE tip of A1.

#### Transmission

- Operating voltage: 69 kV.
- Currently capacity: up to 100 MW.
- **Opportunities for growth**: Additional on-site, 161 and 345 kV substation would add up to 1,200 MW of capacity.
- Proximity of substation: Within 2 miles of A1.

## Water supply: City of Cedar Rapids

- Existing capacity to site: 2.8 million gallons per day.
- Future capacity to site: The city of Cedar Rapids is constructing on a water softener that will add an additional 4 million to 5 million gallons per day of availability to the site. Completion is expected summer 2023.

## Fiber supply: City of Cedar Rapids

- South Slope: Serves speeds beyond 1 gigabit.
- ImOn communications: Offers 10 gigabit and higher with some equipment additions.

## Waste water supply: City of Cedar Rapids

• Current capactity: 7 million gallons per day

#### **Zoning: City of Cedar Rapids**

- Fully annexed into the city of Cedar Rapids
- Currently zoned as general industries, the highest zoning class in the city of Cedar Rapids.

#### **Transportation**

Nearest interstate: Interstate 380 (5 minutes), Interstate 80 (20 minutes), Interstate 35 (90 minutes).

Nearest four-lane highway: U.S. Highway 30 (1 mile).

Nearest commercial airport: The Eastern Iowa Airport (2 miles).

Rail served: CRANDIC Rail connects to all Class I railroads.
