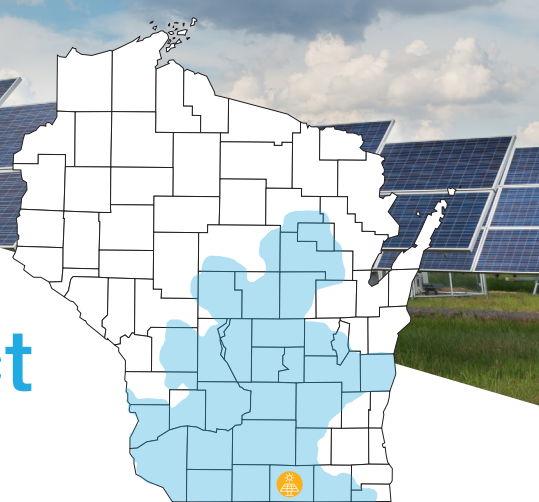


# North Rock Solar Project

January 2023 update



The 50-megawatt (MW) North Rock Solar Project located in Rock County, Wisconsin, is part of Alliant Energy's Clean Energy Blueprint, a strategic roadmap to cost-effectively accelerate our transition to renewable energy and reduce carbon emissions. Now complete, the project will positively impact the environment and generate enough energy to power 13,000 homes.

## Project update

Construction is officially complete at the North Rock Solar Project. It is now generating clean energy for the grid. We expect the project to provide renewable energy for approximately 13,000 homes annually.

We're pleased to share that with nearly 140,000 hours worked on-site, there were no recordable injury incidents. That means every worker went home safely to their family.

This is one of our first large-scale solar projects to become operational and begin our transition to renewable energy in Wisconsin.

With the completion of the North Rock Solar Project, Alliant Energy now is the largest owner-operator of solar energy in Wisconsin. With 250 MW of solar production in service, Alliant Energy's Wisconsin customers will benefit from this clean, cost-effective energy for decades to come.

## Benefits to the community

With the North Rock Solar Project now complete, the town of Fulton and Rock County are expected to qualify for a combined shared revenue payment of approximately \$200,000 annually for the life of the project.

The state-administered Shared Revenue Program contributes these payments to the community's annual operating income to be used as local officials deem appropriate.
