ALL PRICING ZONES ALTERNATIVE FUEL SUPPLY SERVICE RIDER AFS

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Applicability: Applicable to all Transportation and Large Interruptible Customers served by Company and having a demonstrated alternative fuel supply source.

Contract Requirements: The Customer and Company shall enter into a written contract specifying the following:

- 1) The terms available to the customer for alternate fuel supplies;
- 2) The renegotiated price for transportation of customer-owned gas, subject to the limitations specified below;
- 3) the term of the agreement, subject to the limitations specified below; and
- 4) other terms and conditions as necessary.

Terms and Conditions:

- A. Length of Contract - No contract shall be written for a period longer than five years.
- B. Pricing Boundaries - The negotiated transportation price shall not be less than zero, nor greater than the full-tariffed rate specified for the class of customer in which the customer would otherwise be classified.
- C. Informational Requirements - Customers taking service under this rider shall be required to supply Company with the data necessary for the Company to reasonably determine the accuracy and appropriateness of negotiated prices.
- D. Contracts signed pursuant to this rider shall be filed with the Iowa Utilities Board on a confidential basis.
- E. All other terms of the applicable rate schedule shall apply.
