GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR GAS SERVICE CURTAILMENT OF SERVICE

SECTION 12

12.01 GAS SUPPLY: Inadequate gas supplies from Company's Pipeline Suppliers may require Company to curtail service to protect its high priority loads. Where applicable, Company shall curtail service in accordance with the terms and conditions of the FERC Tariff of its Pipeline Suppliers. If the Pipeline Supplier's FERC Tariffs are inapplicable, Company will curtail pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of this section.

12.02 CURTAILMENT OF INTERRUPTIBLE CUSTOMERS: All curtailments of interruptible Customers shall be governed by the terms and conditions of the applicable rate schedules.

12.03 CURTAILMENT OF FIRM CUSTOMERS: Company shall curtail firm Customers on the basis of size, except that residential Customers shall have the highest priority of usage.

12.04 MAXIMIZATION OF GAS SUPPLY: To maximize the amount of interruptible gas available, an interruptible Customer may be required to read all meters installed by Company to provide interruptible gas service, and make available to Company the meter reading records obtained therefrom. The purpose of this requirement is to permit Company to minimize the interruption of service to each of its interruptible Customers. Company shall provide personnel to train said Customer's employees to read properly Company's meters.
