

# Electric rates for residential customers



The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin approved new base electric rates effective Jan. 1, 2024.

The average impact of the adjustment on residential customer bills is approximately \$7.75 per month.<sup>1</sup> Actual costs will vary depending on your rate class and electric usage.

# Natural gas rates for residential customers

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) approved new natural gas base rates effective Jan. 1, 2024 (docket 6680-UR-124). The average impact of the adjustment on residential customer bills is approximately \$4.00 per month.<sup>1</sup> Actual costs will vary depending on your rate class and natural gas usage.
