


Decorah residents are better served by Alliant Energy




Average Alliant Energy rates

The chart below compares the forecasted rates for Alliant Energy customers from Concentric's 2018 study to actual rates from 2017 to 2023. Importantly, both the forecasted and actual rates for Alliant Energy customers are lower than the rates that Decorah customers would have paid if served by the MEU.



Note: The rates in the chart at left represent an average "all-in" rate for all customers (i.e., total customer revenue divided by total consumption), meaning that it includes fixed charges, riders, and other non-per-kWh charges.
